Unit 1 – Hello! My Name Is...

In Unit 1, students learn to greet others, introduce themselves, and say goodbye with confidence. They'll explore basic emotions, answer the question "How are you?", and dive into playful toy vocabulary. The letters A, B, and C are introduced through interactive visuals and fun pronunciation practice.

Unit 2 – Polite and Playful

In this unit, students build on greetings with the cheerful "Hello, How are you?" song and learn polite expressions like "please," "thank you," and "sorry." They'll meet new action words like "go" and "stop" and practice pointing things out using "this" and "that." Letters D, E, and F take center stage, along with vocabulary for people and classroom roles.

Unit 3 – Colors and Pronouns

Unit 3 brings a splash of color! Learners name and share favorite colors, practice new vocabulary, and explore subject pronouns like "I," "you," and "they" with "to be." Letters G, H, and I are introduced through creative word play and games.



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Unit 4 – What Is It?

Students discover vocabulary for transportation and learn to answer the question “What is it?” with complete descriptive phrases. They’ll explore plural nouns, possessive pronouns like “his” and “our,” and meet the letters J, K, and L along the way.

Unit 5 – Numbers and Feelings

This unit is all about counting and expressing age! Students learn numbers 0–10, sing a catchy number song, and ask and answer “How old are you?” They’ll also revisit emotional vocabulary like “tired” and “hungry” with added flair. Letters M, N, and O are introduced with high-energy review games.


Unit 6 – Animals and Adjectives

From “hot” to “cold” and “cow” to “chicken,” Unit 6 blends animal fun with grammar basics. Students form positive and negative sentences (“I am...” / “I am not...”), add intensity with “very,” and sing “Old MacDonald” to reinforce new animal vocabulary. The letters P, Q, and R join the party.

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Unit 7 – Family and Actions

In this dynamic unit, learners meet family members and learn action verbs like “sit,” “stand,” and “jump.” They also explore drinks, build simple present sentences, and try using verbs in the -ing form. The letters S, T, and U round out the phonics fun.

Unit 8 – School and the Wild Side

Time to explore school supplies and jungle animals! Students will learn classroom vocabulary like “pen,” “book,” and “computer,” alongside wild animal names like “tiger” and “elephant.” Key verbs like “talk” and “write” get introduced, and the letters V, W, and X come into focus.

Unit 9 – Body and Movement

In Unit 9, students dance, sing, and learn English terms for their body. They'll learn action verbs in -ing form and dive into vocabulary for body parts—from “head” to “feet” and everything in between. Adjectives help learners describe what they see and feel in complete, colorful sentences.
